

FishOnline training FREE WORKSHOPS ONE HOUR

IF YOU ARE NOT ALREADY REGISTERED AND USING THE FISHERMOBILE APP YOU SHOULD REGISTER NOW TO AVOID THE RUSH LEADING UP TO 1 MAY 2019. ALL FISHERS ARE ENCOURAGED TO ATTEND THE FREE TRAINING WORKSHOPS AS QUOTA USAGE FOR THE IAP SHARE CLASSES MUST BE REPORTED VIA FISHERMOBILE FROM 1 MAY 2019, AND SOME CHANGES WILL APPLY FOR EXISTING USERS

Free training workshops are being held during April 2019 to assist fishers transition to the new online new quota usage reporting requirements and to familiarise existing users with changes that will apply. There are two types of free workshops available:

Workshop 1 (Beginner 1.5hr) - for fishers that are new to the FisherMobile App and real time reporting (includes the new process for multiple species reporting).

Workshop 2 (Experienced 1hr) - for fishers already using the FisherMobile App for real time reporting - this workshop will cover the new process for multiple species reporting and a range of other online services available via FisherMobile and FisherDirect.

These are the only training workshops scheduled. If you choose not to attend you can access the updated user guides and video demonstrations that will be available on the department website at www.dpi.nsw.gov.au/fishing/commercial/fishonline.

If someone assists you with your reporting requirements and business transactions they are welcome to register and attend with you.
